Appendix 9A Art. 7.6	Exhaust The complete exhaust must be the original exhaust according to the Carrera Cup regulations. Additional silencers are allowed with the sole purpose to fulfil the applicable noise measures limits. An open exhaust is not permitted.	Exhaust A standard exhaust (Abgasanlage) with silencer is compulsory. This includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Catalytic converter (Krummer) - Silencer (Abgasschaldaempfer Standard) With main part numbers 99111302192, 99111302292, 99711102792 Additional silencers are allowed with the sole purpose of meeting the applicable noise limits. An open exhaust is not permitted.

Art. 6 Deviations and additional regulations for type 992

Add following article:

6.5 Other deviations

Shock absorbers	Brand, model and type of shock absorbers and springs are free, according to chapter II of these regulations. Automatic, semi-automatic and/or electronic controlled dampers or shock absorbers are only allowed if described in the homologation/Porsche Carrera Cup Technical regulations.
