GENERAL INFORMATION

- **Live timing and live stream**

Below the information on how you can receive the timing and scoring and live feed signal:

 - The timing and scoring and the TV feed shall be provided with the wireless DVB-T standard.
 - To receive this signal, the device (e.g. TV) must be equipped with a DVB-T tuner or receiver and an antenna to receive the signal
- **Track Shipping**

If needed, you can send packages to Dubai Autodrome. Please make sure that all charges such as import duties are covered. Dubai Autodrome will not accept the delivery if these charges are not paid. It is important to include your team name so that the circuit knows the package is for you.

If you are planning to send a bigger shipment (e.g. full pallet), please make sure that this does not arrive too early as they cannot storage this for a long time.

- **Cooking paddock**

Cooking by teams in the paddock will be allowed but:

 - No open flames, i.e. only electric stove cooking
 - You must bring your own fire extinguisher to keep in the area where you will cook

Please note that the rules regarding cooking are strict and will be checked! Cooking in the pit box is not allowed!

EVENT INFORMATION

- **New Qualifying structure**

From Dubai onwards, three drivers per car will be involved in the qualifying session and the average lap time will be used as the set qualifying time. The full qualifying regulations can be found in Chapter I, art. 32 of the Sporting Regulations.
- **Revised Pit Stop regulations**

in 2022, the pit stop regulations are amended, with the goal of increased safety, cost reduction and generating more time and help for amateur drivers to exit- and enter the car during a pit stop. Full pit stop regulations can be found under Chapter I, art. 21.2 of the Sporting Regulations.
- **Unofficial Exclusive Test Monday**

On Monday 10 January, four Unofficial Exclusive Test Sessions of 2 hours each take place. If you would like to book these sessions, please inform us via email.
Times: 09:00-11:00 / 11:00-13:00 / 14:00-16:00 / 16:00-18:00
- **Unofficial Private Test Wednesday**

There are two optional private test session, 2,5 hours each available on Wednesday 12 January before the race. One session is included in the medium entry fee package and both sessions are included in the complete entry fee package.
- **Instructor / passenger private test**

It is allowed to start in the sessions above with an instructor as a passenger, given he/she is wearing fully homologated protective gear and is holder of a valid racing license.
- **Refuelling**

The refuelling area is located at the end of the pit lane. It is possible to refuel on both the RIGHT and LEFT hand side of the cars. Your fuel inlet needs to be prepared to refuel with a standard (commercial) fuel-pump-pistol, therefore the refuelling orifices of the tank must be equipped for this operation.

SCRUTINEERING & TECHNICAL INFORMATION

- **AIM Datalogger** For classes GT3, GT4, 992, 991 and TCR, please make sure you have to correct AIM datalogger (Evo5 or Evo4). Order form can be found at the **order information section**.
- **Exhaust GT3 & Porsche 991 & 992** The following technical regulations are in force with immediate application:
 - **Class GT3** – Complete Exhaust must be according GT3-homologation
 - **Class 991 & 992** – Complete Exhaust must be according to the standard silencer

HELMET, FHR-SYSTEM & CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

The Helmet, FHR-System & Clothing requirements for 24H SERIES 2022 [can be found here](#).

If you are running a car in the GT3 class, please pay extra attention to the FIA Regulations below:

- **GT3 Only: Helmet FIA Standard** Drivers with a GT3 car must have a helmet with FIA standard 8860-2018 or 8860-2018-ABP. Please note that other Helmet FIA Standards are NOT accepted for GT3 drivers.
- **GT3 only: Driver Clothing** For all GT3 drivers clothing: the new FIA 8856-2018 standard is mandatory per 1.1.2022 (FIA Technical list no 74). Clothing with standard 8856-2000 is **no longer valid after 31.12.2021**
- **Offer Speedcom - helmets & Clothing** Speedcom has an exclusive offer for Creventic events for helmets & drivers clothing which meet the new FIA Regulations for **GT3 drivers** in International races. The offers for the helmets (FIA Standard 8860-2018) and drivers clothing (FIA Standard 8856-2018) can be found in the team information email from 17-11-2021

One beach flag must be fixed to the fence in the pit lane and the other one must be placed on the paddock next to the truck. If a team's beach flag is broken or lost, the team must request a new beach flag at Creventic at additional costs of 100 EURO per flag.
