## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Live timing and live stream**  
 Below the information on how you can receive the timing and scoring and live feed signal:
  - The timing and scoring and the TV feed shall be provided with the wireless DVB-T standard.
  - To receive this signal, the device (e.g. TV) must be equipped with a DVB-T tuner or receiver and an antenna to receive the signal
- Track Shipping**  
 You can send packages to Dubai Autodrome. Please make sure that all charges such as import duties are covered. Dubai Autodrome will not accept the delivery if these charges are not paid. It is important to include your team name so that the circuit knows the package is for you.  
  
 If you are planning to send a bigger shipment (e.g. full pallet), please make sure that this does not arrive too early as they cannot storage this for a long time.

- Cooking paddock**  
 Cooking by teams in the paddock will be allowed but:
  - No open flames, i.e. only electric stove cooking
  - You must bring your own fire extinguisher to keep in the area where you will cook
  - BBQ's are not permitted under any circumstances
 Please note that the rules regarding cooking are strict and will be checked! Cooking in the pit box is not allowed!

- Maximum number of crew members**  
 At the moment, there will be no limitation on the number of team members.
- Access requirements circuit**  
 In order to have access to the circuit, each person must present one of the proofs below.
  - Negative PCR test which is no older than 72 hours on Thursday 13 January
  - A proof of COVID-19 Vaccination

**Please note:** checks will start on Thursday 13 January so in case a person is not vaccinated and will access the circuit with a PCR test, the test cannot be older than 72 hours on Thursday 13 January.

## EVENT INFORMATION

- New Qualifying structure** From Dubai onwards, three drivers per car will be involved in the qualifying session and the average lap time will be used as the set qualifying time. The full qualifying regulations can be found in Chapter I, art. 32 of the Sporting Regulations.
- Revised Pit Stop regulations** in 2022, the pit stop regulations are amended, with the goal of increased safety, cost reduction and generating more time and help for amateur drivers to exit- and enter the car during a pit stop. Full pit stop regulations can be found under Chapter I, art. 21.2 of the Sporting Regulations.
- Unofficial test sessions**

On Monday 10 January, four Unofficial Exclusive Test Sessions of 2 hours each take place:  
 Times: 09:00-11:00 / 11:00-13:00 / 14:00-16:00 / 16:00-18:00

On Wednesday 12 January, two Unofficial Private Test Sessions of 2,5 hours each take place. One session is included in the medium package and both sessions in the complete package.

It is allowed to start in the Unofficial test sessions with an instructor as a passenger, given he/she is wearing fully homologated protective gear and is holder of a valid racing license.
- Administrative check** The administrative check takes place at the following days/times:
  - Monday 10 January 08:30 – 18:00
  - Tuesday 11 January 09:00 – 18:00
  - Wednesday 12 January 08:30 – 12:00

**Please note:** drivers taking part in the unofficial test sessions must sign the entry form before these sessions in order to receive the required private test bracelet.

All drivers received an email requesting to submit their entry details and to send their new 2022 license. Please make sure that your drivers submit their details in advance.

- Competitor & Driver licenses 2022** In Dubai it is required for all drivers and competitors to have the 2022 license. If the ASN is not able to provide you with the physical license in time, please make sure to have a written confirmation from the ASN confirming that you have a license and that they have no objection of you competing in this event.
- Refuelling** The refuelling area is located at the end of the pit lane. It is possible to refuel on both the RIGHT and LEFT hand side of the cars. Your fuel inlet needs to be prepared to refuel with a standard (commercial) fuel-pump-pistol, therefore the refuelling orifices of the tank must be equipped for this operation.

## SCRUTINEERING & TECHNICAL INFORMATION

- AIM Datalogger** For classes GT3, GT4, 992, 991 and TCR, please make sure you have to correct AIM datalogger (Evo5 or Evo4). Order form can be found at the **order information section**.
- Exhaust GT3 & Porsche 991 & 992** The following technical regulations are in force with immediate application (see Series Bulletin 01 for detailed regulations):
  - Class GT3** – Katalysator and silencer are mandatory
  - Class 991 & 992** – Exhaust with silencer mandatory
- Window net compulsory** From Dubai onwards a window net is compulsory. The arm restraint is no longer allowed.
- Checklist Scrutineering** The checklist will help teams to have a fast and smooth scrutineering and it is obligatory to complete this checklist and bring it with you to Scrutineering. [The checklist and compulsory advertising can be found here](#)
- Scrutineering time slot per car** Each car will have a fixed time slot for Scrutineering which will be send to you in the first week of January

## HELMET, FHR-SYSTEM & CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

The Helmet, FHR-System & Clothing requirements for 24H SERIES 2022 [can be found here](#).

If you are running a car in the GT3 class, please pay extra attention to the FIA Regulations below:

- GT3 Only: Helmet FIA Standard** Drivers with a GT3 car must have a helmet with FIA standard 8860-2018 or 8860-2018-ABP. Please note that other Helmet FIA Standards are NOT accepted for GT3 drivers.
- GT3 only: Driver Clothing** For all GT3 drivers clothing: the new FIA 8856-2018 standard is mandatory per 1.1.2022 (FIA Technical list no 74). Clothing with standard 8856-2000 is **no longer valid after 31.12.2021**
- Offer Speedcom - helmets & Clothing** Speedcom has an exclusive offer for Creventic events for helmets & drivers clothing which meet the new FIA Regulations for **GT3 drivers** in International races. The offers for the helmets (FIA Standard 8860-2018) and drivers clothing (FIA Standard 8856-2018) can be found in the team information email from 17-11-2021

## PIT BOX, PADDOCK & CONTAINER INFO

- Pit box & Paddock allocation** TBA
- Access to container and pit box** On the following days/times, teams will have access to their container and pit box:
  - Sunday 9 January 10:00 – 18:00 (Monday test & Sebring teams only)
  - Monday 10 January 13:00 – 18:00 (Early access teams (medium & complete package))
  - Tuesday 11 January 09:00 – 18:00 (Regular access / all other teams)
- Paddock Space** As there are a lot of cars entered this means that all pit boxes will be used and that we will have a full paddock. The emergency lane (space next to each stairs) must be kept free at all times so this means that the available space will be divided to all pit boxes, see below:
  - If you have a 3-shared pit box, your space on the paddock is 4,9 x 4 meter per car
  - If you have a 2-shared pit box, your space on the paddock is 4,9 x 6 meter per car
  - If you have an exclusive pit box, your space on the paddock is 4,9 x 12 meter

- Driver badges** The Hankook, 24H SERIES and 24H DUBAI badges are mandatory and need to be placed in the chest area. No tyre brand except Hankook may be visible on the driver overall. - Personalised team beach flags** Each team will receive at the first race they participate, two personalised beach flags representing their team, nationality, car and class. The team itself is responsible to take the beach flags with them at each event they in the 24H SERIES.

One beach flag must be fixed to the fence in the pit lane and the other one must be placed on the paddock next to the truck. If a team's beach flag is broken or lost, the team must request a new beach flag at Creventic at additional costs of 100 EURO per flag.
