- **LUMIRANK & STS Driver Info Display** Both the LUMIRANK LED Display and Driver Info Display will be provided by Creventic and rental of the items is included in the entry fee. A deposit of 1.500 euro will be charged. When the items are returned in good order, the deposit will be refunded.

- **Illuminated back panels (set)** As the race will partly be in the dark, illuminated back panels are mandatory for the Hankook 24H DUBAI 2024. Please send teams@creventic.com an email with the request for illuminated backpanels (€300,-) if you would like to order them.
- **Datalogger** All cars in class GT3, select GTX cars (according to BoP publication), 992, GT4 & TCR must be equipped with a datalogger. The datalogger can be rented or purchased at AIM Scrutineering. [Click here for the Datalogger order form](#)
Please note: according to art. 10.9 of the Supplementary Regulations: For all Cars, with datalogger, for which one or more pressure sensor(s) is mandatory: AIM pressure sensor X05PSA00005B10AK, measuring range: 0 – 5 bar absolute is obligatory. This is part number M20-D15-0 and can be ordered at: technical@aim-scrutineering.com. Any other pressure sensors are no longer allowed.
- **Accident Data Recorder** The Accident Data Recorder (ADR) is mandatory for all GT3 cars per January 1st, 2023. The Accident Data Recorder is not included in the entry fee and must be ordered from one of the FIA-approved suppliers.
Please contact the manufacturer for advise as to what ADR you need as they can help you accordingly. Please note: in most cases the GT3 manufacturer does not sell the Accident Data Recorder and it must be ordered from one of the FIA-approved suppliers. - **Health & Safety Rules**

- **Track Shipping**

If needed, you can send packages to Dubai Autodrome. Please make sure that all charges such as import duties are covered. Dubai Autodrome will not accept the delivery if these charges are not paid. It is important to include your team name so that the circuit knows the package is for you.

If you are planning to send a bigger shipment (e.g. full pallet), please make sure that this does not arrive too early as they cannot storage this for a long time.

- **Cooking paddock**

Cooking by teams in the paddock will be allowed but:

 - No open flames, i.e. only electric stove cooking
 - You must bring your own fire extinguisher to keep in the area where you will cook
 - BBQ's are not permitted under any circumstances

Please note that the rules regarding cooking are strict and will be checked! **Cooking in the pit box is not allowed!**

EVENT INFORMATION

- **Race**

The race will start on Saturday 13 January 2024 at 13:00 and will finish the next day at 13:00.
- **Qualifying**

Qualifying for the Hankook 24H DUBAI 2024 will take place on Friday 12 January 2024 and will be split as followed:

 - 14:40 – 15:35 Qualifying 1, 2 and 3 for TC, TCR, TCX and GT4
 - 15:45 – 16:40 Qualifying 1, 2 and 3 for GTX and 992
 - 16:50 – 17:45 Qualifying 1, 2 and 3 for GT3
- **Creventic Track Day Sessions**

On Monday 8 January, Tuesday 9 January and Wednesday 10 January Creventic will host various Track Day Sessions of 2 hours each. If you would like to book any of these sessions, please inform us via email: teams@creventic.com.

- **Private Test Thursday**

There are two optional private test session, 2,5 hours each, available on Thursday 11 January. One session is included in the medium entry fee package and both sessions are included in the complete entry fee package.
- **Instructor private test**

It is allowed to start in the sessions above with an instructor, given he/she is wearing fully homologated protective gear and is holder of a valid racing license and has a valid seat and seat belts. Please note that all instructors must sign a waiver before participating in the private test sessions.
- **Rent a Car Ride**

On Thursday 11 January a Rent a Car Ride will take place from 9:30-10:00. This Rent a Car Ride is included in each of the Entry Fee packages. The Medium and Complete package teams receive two Rent a Car Ride stickers.

During the Rent a Car Ride normal road cars are allowed to enter the track. **No race cars are allowed.** All drivers and passengers who enter the track need to sign the liability waiver. After this waiver is signed, the participant receives a wristband which gives them access to the track. The speed limit is set to 80km/hour.



- **Refueling**

In Dubai we will bring the new Creventic fuel stations, like successfully used from the Hankook 24H PORTIMAO 2022 onwards. All teams will receive the personalized fuel tag. The fuel stations will be in the refueling area at the end of the pitlane. In total 5 fuel units (10 hoses) will be operational. Depending on the selected fuel station, the fuel unit will be on the right hand side or the left hand side. The provided fuel will be Petrol Octane 98.
- **Administrative Check**

The administrative checks will take place on Monday and Tuesday for the Track Day Sessions. On Wednesday and Thursday there will be the normal administrative checks. These administrative checks are only mandatory for the team managers. Please see below an overview of the times for the admin checks:

 - **Monday 8 January:** 8:30-13:00 and 13:30-18:00
 - **Tuesday 9 January:** 8:30-13:00 and 13:30-18:00
 - **Wednesday 10 January:** 8:30-13:00 – 13:30-16:00
 - **Thursday 11 January:** 8:30-12:00 (on appointment only)

All drivers must complete their administrative check in the 24H SERIES app before the event. The drivers receive their log-in details for the app soon.
- **Competitors & Driver licenses 2024**

From the 24H DUBAI 2024 onwards it is required for all drivers and competitors to have their 2024 license. If the ASN is not able to provide you with the physical license in time, please make sure to have a written confirmation from the ASN confirming that you have a valid license. All drivers must submit the authorisation of their ASN (according to art. 2.3.7 of the FIA International Sporting Code). The ASN authorisation must mention: The ASN authorizes [driver name] to participate in the Hankook 24H DUBAI 2024 (national event abroad).

- CODE 60**

Creventic and the 24H SERIES use a CODE 60 to neutralize the race in case of an incident instead of a Safety Car. The main advantage of the CODE 60 procedure is that the entire track is secured immediately and assure that officials and marshals can do their important work as soon as possible. For the drivers, this procedure is simple to follow: when the purple CODE 60 flags are shown, drivers have to release the throttle immediately and slow to 60km/h without braking.
- Driver line-up requirements removed**

The Classes will be solely split by the driving time requirements (art. 11.4). Teams must select 10 days prior to the Event which Class they will enter based on their own driver line-up (art. 25.1 and 25.2). The only line-up requirement that remains is minimum 1 AM driver, except when there is no PRO driver. In GT3 and 992 these teams must be in the PRO Class, in the other classes these teams will have a special SEMI-PRO BOP. Max 2 PRO drivers no longer applies.
- Advantage-BOP GT3-AM and 992-AM**

With the change to 25% Max Refuelling under Code60 for 2024 Regulations (but also valid for ME-TROPHY 2023-2024), the Advantage-BOP is set as follows:

For GT3-AM teams and 992-AM teams **with full AM-driver line up**, gaining for BOP-AM-Advantage, the max refuelling amount is set to 50%.

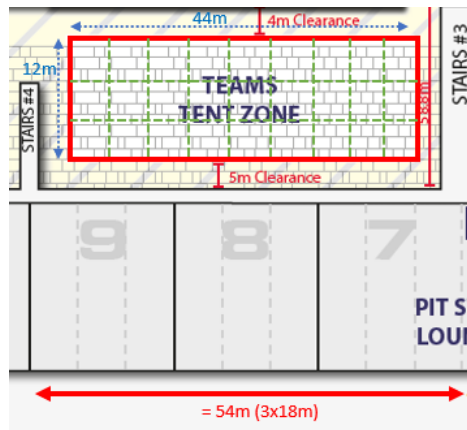


- **Safety Harness (seat-belts)** Per January 1st 2023 the FIA Homologated 5 or 6 points safety harness must be according to FIA Standard 8853/2016. Any seat belt with 8853/98 is not allowed anymore.

PIT BOX & PADDOCK INFORMATION

- **Pit box & Paddock allocation** TBA
- **Pit box preference** To make sure that we are well prepared for the event, we would like to ask you to let us know about your pit box preference before 20 November 2023.
- **Access to pit box and container** On the following days/times, teams will have access to the pit box, paddock and their container:
 - Sunday 7 January 10:00 (Monday Track Day Teams only)
 - Monday 8 January 14:00-18:00 (Tuesday and Wednesday Track Day Teams only)
 - Tuesday 9 January 10:00 (Regular access)Teams must leave their pit box and the paddock by Sunday 23:30.
- **Pit box keys** The security of Dubai Autodrome will open all garages. If a team is alone in the garage and leaves the venue, they can contact security or approach any of the roaming security to lock the doors.
- **Pit box dimensions** Dimensions of the pit box are: 23 x 6 meter
- **Paddock Space** Each pit box choice comes with it's individual amount of paddock space. Please find below how much paddock space will be received based on your pit box choice:
 - Exclusive pit box 4,88m x 12m
 - 2-Shared pit box 4,88m x 6m
 - 3-Shared pit box 4,88m x 4m

TEAM INFORMATION – V1: 15-11-2023

- **Personalised team beach flags**

Each team will receive at the first race they participate, two personalised beach flags representing their team, nationality, car and class. The team itself is responsible to take the beach flags with them at each event they in the 24H SERIES.

One beach flag must be fixed to the fence in the pit lane and the other one must be placed on the paddock next to the truck. If a team's beach flag is broken or lost, the team must request a new beach flag at Creventic at additional costs of 100 EURO per flag.
