EVENT INFORMATION

Code60-Safetycar Procedure (CSP)

A safety car to restart the race after a race neutralization (Code60), cars which are trapped between their class leader and the safety car will be allowed to overtake (Pass-By) the safety car and re-join the back of the field. The Goal of pass-by is to solve the negative side effect of Safety Car at multiclass racing. During Code 60 and/or CSP-procedure, the maximum refuel amount for all cars is 10 L

• Driver changes and driving time

- Minimum 3 driver changes mandatory
- No minimum or maximum driving time requirements
- No minimum rest-time requirements

Unofficial test sessions

On Thursday 20 January, a 3 hour open pitlane session will take place. This test is not included in an entry fee package and needs to be ordered separately. If you would like to take part in this session, please inform us via email.

On Friday 21 January, two private test sessions of 1,5 hours each take place. 1 session is included in the medium package and both sessions are included in the complete package.

• Administrative check

All drivers (except drivers who also participated in the 24H DUBAI) must submit their entry details and their new 2022 license in advance. Please make sure that all your drivers have submitted their details. The entry details can be submitted here

• License requirements 2022

- Drivers need minimum a National license
- Or International ITC-C or ITD-C license
- All foreign drivers must have an authorisation of their ASN

Refuelling

The refuelling area is located at the beginning of the pit lane. Your fuel inlet needs to be prepared to refuel with a standard (commercial) fuel-pump-pistol, therefore the refuelling orifices of the tank must be equipped for this operation.

AIM Datalogger

For classes GT3, GT, 992, TCR & TG (GT4 cars) please make sure you have to correct AIM datalogger (Evo5 or Evo4). Order form can be found at the **required items for the race section.**

• Exhaust GT3 & Porsche 991 & 992

The following technical regulations are in force with immediate application:

- Class GT3 Katalysator and silencer are mandatory
- 991 & 992 cars Exhaust with silencer mandatory

Driver badges
 The Hankook badge is mandatory and need to be placed in the chest area. No tyre brand except
 Hankook may be visible on the driver overall. The Hankook badge will be available on-site.

Personalised team beach flags

Each team will receive two personalised beach flags representing their team, nationality, car and class. The team itself is responsible to take the beach flags with them at each event they in the 24H SERIES.

One beach flag must be fixed to the fence in the pit lane and the other one must be placed on the paddock next to the truck. If a team's beach flag is broken or lost, the team must request a new beach flag at Creventic at additional costs of 100 EURO per flag.
