Track Day Sessions Wednesday

On Wednesday 22 March, four Track Day Sessions take place of 2 hours each. These sessions are not included in any package and need to be booked separately. If you would like to book extra sessions, then please inform us via email: teams@creventic.com.

Times: 9:00-11:00 / 11:00-13:00 / 14:00-16:00 / 16:00-18:00 Price per session is:

- €1.750,- for one block
- €3.000,- for two blocks
- €5.000,- for four blocks

Prices are including fuel. A €50,- discount will be given when driving on Hankook tyres from C&R Motorsport.

Two blocks include 10 Wednesday Lunch tickets, and four blocks include 10 Wednesday Lunch & Dinner tickets.

It is allowed to start in the Track Day sessions with an instructor, given he/she is wearing fully homologated protective gear and is holder of a valid racing license.

Unofficial Private Test Thursday

On Thursday 23 March, two unofficial private test sessions take place of 3 hours each.

One session is included in the medium package and both sessions in the complete package.

It is allowed to start in the Unofficial test sessions with an instructor, given he/she is wearing fully homologated protective gear and is holder of a valid racing license.

Refuelling

In Mugello we will bring the new Creventic fuel stations, introduced in 2022 and successfully used from the Hankook 24H PORTIMAO 2022 onwards. All teams will receive their personalized fuel tag. The fuel stations will be in the refueling area at the beginning of the pitlane. Depending on the selected fuel station, the fuel unit will be on the right-hand side or the left-hand side. The provided fuel will be Petrol Octane 98.

CODE 60

Creventic and the 24H SERIES use a CODE 60 to neutralize the race in case of an incident instead of a Safety Car. The main advantage of the CODE 60 procedure is that the entire track is secured immediately and assure that officials and marshals can do their important work as soon as possible. For the drivers, this procedure is simple to follow: when the purple CODE 60 flags are shown, drivers have to release the throttle immediately and slow to 60km/h without braking.

992 and 992-AM Class

A full AM Driver line-up in the 992 and 992-AM Class will benefit from 100% refuelling under CODE 60. With the introduction of the new 992 and 992-AM Class structure, Creventic has given the AM teams their own class and competition. By applying a different BOP for 992-PRO and 992-AM teams the AM teams are also able to compete for a podium. The difference in BOP is a 25% faster refuelling rate (fuel flow) for the 992-AM teams compared to 992-PRO. Please note; Creventic can apply reduced refuelling rates since Creventic has its own professional and dedicated central fuel station. For detailed regulations, please see art. 44.3 of the 24H SERIES Sporting Regulations 2023.

From Mugello onwards 992-AM teams with a full AM Driver line-up will benefit from 992-AM Advantage BOP and may refuel 100% under CODE 60, instead of only 50%. This means that 992-AM teams with a full AM driver line-up will benefit from 100% refuelling under CODE 60, while other 992-AM and 992 teams are only allowed to refuel 50% under CODE 60. Driver badges

The Hankook and 24H SERIES badges are mandatory and need to be placed in the chest area. No tyre brand except Hankook may be visible on the driver overall. All badges will be available on-site or can be downloaded as vector (see zip file under "official documents"): www.24hseries.com/team-info/general-info/download-logos-and-driver-badges/badges

Personalised team beach flags

Each team will receive at the first race they participate, two personalised beach flags representing their team, nationality, car and class. The team itself is responsible to take the beach flags with them at each event they in the 24H SERIES.

One beach flag must be fixed to the fence in the pit lane and the other one must be placed on the paddock next to the truck. If a team's beach flag is broken or lost, the team must request a new beach flag at Creventic at additional costs of 100 EURO per flag.
