

# ***Environmental protection regulations***



## **1. General organisation**

The organiser will ensure that all participants comply with the environmental protection regulations of Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG with all participants and will also draw attention to this in a suitable form in the tender documents.

When handling water-polluting substances (oil, fuel, etc.), special care must be taken.

Leakage damage and other environmental hazards must be reported immediately to the start/finish house of Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG immediately.

The track marshals and all other responsible persons are advised by the organiser that any oil or fuel spillage must be soaked up with oil binding agents and then disposed of in the red waste bins at the used oil depots.

The boxes rented by the organiser will be returned swept clean and any carpet laid out will be completely removed from the boxes after the event.

Adhesive tapes for fixing the floor covering must not damage the paint of the pit floors and will also be completely removed after the event.

The organiser shall provide Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG a plan of the paddock layout and a list of the participating hospitality up to 3 days before the start of the event.

## **2. Noise control**

Compliance with the times of use of the race track agreed in the race contract and the noise emissions registered there must be guaranteed by the organiser. Racing outside these times is not permitted.

Unnecessary noise must be avoided.

## **3. Waste avoidance/waste disposal**

Where possible, drinks should be served (not sold) using reusable systems (cups or crockery). Disposable cups and cans should not be served. Reusable crockery or packaging with as little waste as possible will also be used for food.

Waste disposal is always organised by Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG. It is not permitted to commission external companies to dispose of waste on the Nürburgring site.

Waste is separated according to the following waste types:

- Packaging materials/recyclables (yellow bins)
- Glass (glass containers and green bins)
- Paper, cardboard, cardboard (blue lattice boxes)
- Food waste (brown bin)
- Residual waste without recyclables (grey bin)
- Used oil in event-related quantities (used oil depots)
- Oil-containing solids in event-related quantities (waste oil depots)

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Hazardous waste, with the exception of used oil and oil-contaminated solids (oil filters, cleaning rags), will not be disposed of by Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG, but must be removed by the person responsible after the event. This includes, in particular, batteries, brake fluid, cold cleaner and radiator fluid.

Catering or hospitality operators dispose of their waste at their own expense. The necessary containers must be ordered from Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG at least 5 days before the event via Mr. Carsten Vogt (Tel.: 02691 / 302-9181).

Waste containers and their fastening devices may not be removed from their location. Exceptions to this rule require the approval of Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG.

The distribution of flyers, newspapers, magazines and other promotional items in the outdoor area and in the car parks should be avoided for environmental reasons. Exceptions must be agreed in good time before the event with Nürburgring 1927 GmbH & Co. KG in good time before the event.

## **4. Soil protection**

Any contamination of the substrate by environmentally hazardous substances such as oil or fuel must be prevented. When handling such substances, place drip pans or sheets underneath and work carefully. Keep oil absorbents ready and dispose of contaminated absorbent material as hazardous waste in the "red waste oil depots" in the containers provided at the Nürburgring.

## **5. Waste water disposal**

Surface water and waste water are disposed of separately at the Nürburgring..

- Sanitary and kitchen waste water must be discharged into the waste water inlets marked green or into mobile tanks.
- Surface water inlets are labelled red and must not be used for discharging waste water.

The respective wastewater producers bear the costs for the necessary connection pipes to the wastewater inlet or for the installation of mobile wastewater tanks in areas where no wastewater sewer system exists.

Environmentally hazardous substances such as fuel, oil or cold cleaners must not be discharged into the wastewater sewer system.

## **6. Saving energy and water**

Use electricity and water as sparingly as possible. Control the heating and ventilation of buildings as required. Switch off unnecessary energy consumers (stand-by switches, lighting, gensets, etc.). Limit vehicle washing as much as possible.

## **7. Information**

The organiser will forward the environmental protection information for hospitality and catering at the Nürburgring (1) and the environmental protection information for the race teams (2) to the persons concerned. Other persons working in the organisation and contracted companies will also be informed about environmental protection in racing.
