ME-TROPHY Championship format

Middle East Trophy 2023/2024

Status: National UAE Championship with one race abroad

Races counting towards championship:

- 12H KUWAIT 2023
- 24H DUBAI 2024
- 6H ABU DHABI 2024

Driver licences

- Hankook 12H KUWAIT and Hankook 6H ABU DHABI
 - Minimum national licence
- Hankook 24H DUBAI
 - Cars with more than 3 kg/hp International Grade D Circuits
 - Cars between 2 and 3 kg/hp International Grade C Circuit

Podium:

- Overall
- Per Class

Titles:

- Teams per Class
- Drivers per Class
- Ladies Cup per Class

Race podium trophies:

- Teams Overall and Class winners receive unique 24HSERIES race trophy
- Drivers top 3 Overall and per Class receive trophies
- GT3-PRO top 3 receive medals

Championship trophies:

- Teams top 3 per Class championship receive trophies
- Special Trophy powered by Hankook for Team champion per Class
- Drivers top 3 per Class championship receive trophies
- Ladies per Class champion receives trophy

The championship titles will be based on the best two results of any of the three rounds

To be eligible for these titles a team or driver must have participated in at least 2 events

Driver categorisation according to:

- Lowest FIA categorisation of 2023 and 2024 is guide-line
- Drivers born on or after 1 January 1994 (also for Kuwait) ranked SEMI-PRO (equivalent FIA Silver)

Differences ME-TROPHY regulations compared to 24H SERIES 2024

- **Minimum driver rest time** (art. 11.3 of the Sporting regulations)
 For 6H ABU DHABI 2024: No minimum driver rest time applicable
 (For the avoidance of doubt: maximum stint time remains 2 hours and there is no minimum number of mandatory pitstops applicable)
- Driver Licenses
 See Championship format (previous page)
 - ME-TROPHY Championship points

 All 3 races, the "40 points table" is applicable. (So, 24H Dubai; No half way points)

 See art. 6.2 of the Sporting Regulations 24H SERIES 2024

 (6.2 Point allocation for Races from 10 to 24 hours)
