- **Procedure Workshop Tents and Temporary Structures**

All teams using workshop tents are required to comply with the Nürburgring workshop tent regulations. A permit is required for any tent or temporary structure exceeding 75 m² in surface area or 5 m in height. Where applicable, a valid German *Prüfbuch* must be provided.

Please note that the 75 m² limit also applies to:

 - A truck with an attached awning, where the combined surface area of the truck and awning exceeds 75 m².
 - A truck and a separate tent, where the total surface area exceeds 75 m².

If your setup exceeds 75 m² and no valid *Prüfbuch* is available, you must use a separate tent of less than 75 m² that is not connected to the truck. In this case, no certification is required for the tent.

CR Track Days

- **Track Day Sessions**

On 1 July (8 hours) and 2 July (8 hours) you have the possibility to book the CR Track Day Sessions. Bookings can be made via the [registration form](#). **Deadline: 21 June 2026**
- **Track Day – Official Sessions Information**

All race systems (e.g. Lumirank and DID) will be operational from FP onwards. For any questions during the Track Days, please contact Creventic. Once administrative checks are open, race direction will also be available.
- **Instructor Test Sessions**

Test sessions with an instructor are permitted, provided the instructor wears fully homologated protective gear and holds a valid racing license. All instructors must sign a waiver and present their license at the Welcome Center before participating.
- **Passengers**

Passengers are also permitted during test sessions. All passengers must sign a waiver and collect a wristband at the Welcome Center prior to entering the track.
- **Driver License Requirement**

All drivers must hold a valid racing license or driving license. Without one of these, participation is not permitted.

Drivers with an alternative license (e.g. karting or test license) may request approval via 24hseries@gmail.com. Participation is only allowed after written approval. Requests can be submitted up to a maximum of 7 days prior to the event.
- **Track Day Administration**

All drivers must sign a liability waiver from both Creventic before entering the track. This can be done at the Welcome Center or via the 24H SERIES app.

Each driver must provide a valid license as stated above, either uploaded in the app or shown at the Welcome Center. Once approved, drivers will receive a bracelet, which will be checked by marshals at the end of the pit lane.

Event Information

- **Team Registration**

Upon arrival at the circuit, please visit the Welcome Center to collect your event service bag. The Welcome Center will be in the CREVENTIC Endurance Lounge. **Please note that all items, excluding parking passes and stickers, are issued once for the full season.**

From Friday onwards, strict access checks will be in place. Additional passes can be purchased at the Welcome Center for €15 per pass.
- **Team Manager Lanyard**

All team managers must wear a team manager lanyard throughout the event. This lanyard will be given out by Creventic together with the service bag.
- **Refuelling**

The fuel supplier is RON100. The refuelling area is located at the beginning of the pit lane. The fuel pumps will be on the right-hand side of the car. All teams will receive a personal refuelling tag. **There is a deposit of €50 for the fuel tag.**
- **Fuel in the Pit Box**

Please note that fuel is not allowed in the pit box at any time, neither during Track Days nor on official event days.
- **Administrative Check Drivers**

All drivers must complete the event sign-on in advance through the 24H SERIES application.

The administrative check starts before the event, so the earlier a driver submits their information digitally, the sooner required documents, such as waivers and licenses, can be reviewed by our secretary
- **Administration Team Managers**

All team managers must sign the required team documents, including the Entry Form and Class Selection Form, via the 24H application. **The Class Selection Form must be completed no later than 10 days prior to the start of the event.**
- **Starting Tyre Declaration**

Starting Tyre Declaration As per Article 24.5.1 of the Sporting & Technical Regulations, Team Managers must declare the starting tyres for each car using the app. A new option “Start Tyre Registration” is now available in the My Race tab. You can declare the starting tyres by scanning the yellow FIA barcode on the tyre. If the car starts the race on wet tyres, this must also be confirmed in the app.

- **Electrical Equipment & Pressure Cylinders** All teams are required to comply with the Nürburgring regulations regarding electrical equipment and the use of pressure cylinders. [Here](#) you can find the information.

Since the original document is in German, the following points have been identified as the most relevant for your operations:

 - Electrical equipment must meet applicable VDE safety standards.
 - Maximum 2 pressurised air cylinders per pit box or team area on the paddock.
 - Only cylinders actually required for operation may be present inside the pit box or on the team area in the paddock.
 - Changing cylinders during operation is not permitted.
 - Spare cylinders may not be stored inside the pit box or on the team area in the paddock.

Please note that all teams are required to adhere to these regulations. For all specific details and further requirements, we kindly ask you to refer to the attached German document.
