

Dear Teams,

Thank you for your intention of being part of the start of our 2021 season in the Middle East with the Hankook 24H DUBAI and Hankook 6H ABU DHABI. COVID-19 has been dominating our 2020 season and will still influence the upcoming races, including our races in the United Arab Emirates. We are confident that the races can take place and would like to inform you about the current situation in the UAE and a possible back-up solution in case the race could against all odds not take place in the end.

The current situation:

Entering Dubai:

- Possible with a negative PCR test that is maximum 96 hours of age, no quarantine required

Entering Abu Dhabi:

- No quarantine required if a person is already for at least 14 days in the UAE
- Otherwise, 14 days quarantine, independent of a PCR test
- Note: We are in talks with Yas Marina Circuit to establish a “safe zone” on Yas Island that would count as a separate bubble and by that avoid the quarantine.

General note: There are indications for the UAE to introduce fast tests upon entry that could make entering Dubai and Abu Dhabi easier, but nothing is confirmed yet. We will keep you updated. These are special times and it is requiring flexibility and smart thinking. All aimed on a save environment and respecting local rules in order to do what we love to do; racing. We are in close contact with the circuits in Abu Dhabi and Dubai to monitor the daily situation.

We are currently designing a COVID-19 protocol for the 24H DUBAI and 6H ABU DHABI, based on our COVID-19 protocol applied during the European rounds. Generally, contact in between several groups of people will be highly minimized. Shared and exclusive pit boxes will be assigned based on a first pay-first confirmed basis. Please find the entry package overview attached.

Confirming your entry to the 24H DUBAI/6H ABU DHABI

We are aware that it is not easy to commit 100% to the races at the moment and would already like to inform you that we are willing to share the financial risk involved together with you. Therefore, the following rules regarding entry fee payment and refund apply:

- Latest 20 November 2020, the following fees must be transferred:
 - o EUR 2.500 per car entered as a shared transport fee contribution (please note that this is only a part of the total transportation costs, CREVENTIC has decided to take cover the risk of the remaining transportation costs that are included in the entry fee)
 - o (OPTIONAL): EUR 3.500 in case you have an exclusive container
 - o (OPTIONAL): Trucking costs of your container
 - o (OPTIONAL): Warehouse loading fee
 - o In case you arrange your transportation (sea-freight) yourself, a 50% payment of the basic entry fee is required until latest 15 December 2020
 - o Please note: These transportation costs are non-refundable.
 - o We expect the loading date to be on 30 November – 1 December 2020
 - o Make sure to fill in your shipping information as soon as possible via the shipping form at: <https://www.24hseries.com/downloads/general-info/transport-sea-freighttransport>
 - o Any container must remain in the same configuration for the entire duration of the trip, also if the container is shared with another team. This includes the trip between Dubai and Abu Dhabi as well.
- Latest 4 January 2021, the outstanding balance of the entry fee package and any additionally booked items for the races must be transferred
 - o This applies in case we can give the final go for the race
 - o In case the race would not take place, only the transportation charges (see above) apply
 - o In case the race does take place, but a team withdraws due to a lack of drivers, 50% of the basic entry package still apply

Possible scenarios

As mentioned before, we expect the 24H DUBAI and 6H ABU DHABI to take place as planned, but we have prepared the following scenarios if new regulations prevent this.

Scenario A: The races go ahead as scheduled:

- CREVENTIC will assist with official invitations to make travelling easier
- The fees as outlined above must be paid
- Both races take place on their respective dates

Scenario B: Quarantine regulations in Abu Dhabi will not be amended for Yas Island

- In this case, the 24H DUBAI are not affected and take place as scheduled
- An alternate 6-hour race on Dubai Autodrome will be offered on Tuesday 12 January to all competitors of the 6H ABU DHABI
- In case the competitors join the alternative, the same entry fee applies
- In case the competitors do not join the alternative, only the transportation contribution, as outlined above, applies

Scenario C: Restrictions and regulations in the UAE will be stricter and both races cannot take place

- In this case, we would ship the cars back to Europe at the earliest convenience and organize a back-up race in the beginning on 4-7 February 2021 in Southern Europe
- In case the competitors join the alternative:
 - o The entry fee of the 24H DUBAI applies
 - o Please note that the containers would be unloaded during this event and all equipment and cars must be collected on site with the team's trailers
- In case the competitors do not join the alternative:
 - o The container will be shipped back to the port of origin at the earliest convenience
 - o Only the transportation contribution, as outlined above, applies

We are working full speed with strong focus on both events in the UAE and are very positive that everything can go ahead as planned. We hope that this information makes the situation, possible scenarios and financial commitment clearer. If you have any questions, you are always welcome to contact us.
