

Creventic Driver Categorisation Procedure

Introduction

The Creventic driver categories are assigned per driver by the promoter. The FIA-driver categorisation deals as a guideline. Drivers, that are not mentioned on the FIA-list are assigned their Creventic driver category on the basis of their experience and race results. Creventic may decide to assign a different driver category to a driver than the equivalent FIA-category.

1) Creventic Driver Categories regulations (see Sporting Regulations art. 8.3.1)

The promoter will determine the driver category (PRO, SEMI-PRO or AM) in which the FIA-drivers category list is a guideline.

Driver Category	Requirements
PRO	level FIA Gold or FIA Platinum
SEMI-PRO	level FIA Silver
AM	level FIA Bronze, or not on FIA-list

The promoter will decide upon possible waivers

2) Driver Categorisation procedure and relevant FIA driver category lists

- The Creventic driver category (AM, SEMI-PRO or PRO) is assigned, using the FIA driver category as a guideline.
- For each race, the FIA driver category list 6 weeks prior to the race is used as the guideline.
- If the driver category in the latest FIA driver category list on Monday before the race is lower than in the FIA driver category list 6 weeks prior to the race, the lowest category will be used as a guideline.
- The promoter will decide upon possible waivers, see notes below:

*Drivers that are not on the FIA-list will be assigned their category by Creventic, based on their experience and race results. This does not necessarily need to be AM.

**Drivers that believe that are ranked Silver on the FIA-list only due to their age and not due to their skills, may request to be assigned the AM-category for Creventic races. Each request is handled individually.
