Chapter I Art. 8.1.1	<p>8.1.1 LICENSE</p> <p>All drivers, competitors and officials participating in 24H-MEC must hold current and valid licenses.</p> <p>24H-MEC is open to Competitors holding a National ATCUAE valid Competitor (or driver) License or an international Competitor (or Driver) license (minimum grade C). Only licence holders from the MENA Zone are eligible to score points.</p> <p>Foreign competitors must submit the authorization of their ASN (see Art. 3.9 ISC)</p> <p>According to International Sporting Code (art. 9.1 of ISC) if a team does not have a team competitor licence, the competitor will become the first driver in the entry form and entry list.</p> <p>For publication and ranking purposes the competitor must register a Team name.
